<u>Narrator.</u> "Wingnut and Bootlace, two Angels from the Jerusalem Squadron, are waiting together during a lull between Assignments. To pass the time, they swap stories about things they've seen and heard."

<u>Boot</u> "I'll tell you this story I heard from Geoffrey at the Temple"

Wing "Geoffrey?....All the action takes place on his turf!"

<u>Boot</u> "Yes, he does get his share all right....Anyway Jesus was by the Temple, and this crowd of men came by and two of them were dragging a woman along...."

Wing "The brutes..."

<u>Boot</u> "Yes...and they threw her down at Jesus's feet and this Bigwig pointed at her and said "This woman was caught in adultery in the very act...now Moses in the Law commanded us to stone such as one but what do you say?"

Wing "Did they think He'd say different from the Law?"

Boot "They hoped He would...so they could accuse Him."

Wing "So?....What did He say?"

Jesus (Stands and looks around at the faces.) "He that is without sin among you,
let him cast the first stone at her." (He stoops and continues writing.)
(They stand looking at each other...Scribe one turns and leaves.)

guys"
(The other 2 look at each other and leave also.)
Jesus (Looks up and sees the woman standing alone.) "Where are your
accusers...has no man accused you?"
Woman "No man Lord"
Jesus "Neither do I condemn you...Go...and sin no more."
Boot "That fixed them"
Wing "Sure did!"
Boot "A word fitly spoken is like apples of Gold in pictures of silver."
Wing "You got that right."
Boot "Yes, never a man spoke like that Man."
Wing "So what did it say?"
Boot "What?"
Wing "You know what...the writing on the ground"
Boot "You don't look at things like that."
Wing "Why not?"

Wing "So He didn't?"
