Rev (He taps Teen 1 on the shoulder)..."Excuse me?"

Teen 1 "Yea."

Rev "In Church?"

Teen 1 "Yea."

Rev "While I'm speaking?"

Teen 1 "Yes....You told us to!"

Rev "I did not!"

<u>Teen 1</u> "Yes...Last week you said 'Let God's Word be true, and every mans word be a lie."

Rev "What?"
