(Joe, Barnsey, and Filthy are sitting on the couch drinking beer)

Bar. "Well guys, I think the Boys Club is the best thing ever!"

Fil. "You got that right."

Joe. "Harriet isn't so convinced of that."

Fil. "Why not?"

Joe. "She says we're Alcoholics."

Bar. "Us?...Alkies?"

Joe. "Yeah."

Fil. "We aren't Alkies."

Bar. "No we aren't."

Joe. "That's what I said."

Fil. "Alkies go to meetings....Like AA meetings!"

Bar. "Yeah....That's right."

Fil. "Yeah...You have to go to those meetings to be an Alky."

Joe. "And we don't go to any meetings."

Bar. "Nope."

Fil. "So we aren't Alkies."

Joe. "Nope...We're just Drunks."
