Performers x 2 Reverend Wolff In Sheep's Clothing/Narrator

Mrs Adulteress

Props 2x Chairs

(back to front collar for Reverend)

(MA knocks at the door RW opens it.)

MA "Ah...Hello Reverend....I'm Mrs Adulteress..."

RW "Hello child ...I'm Reverend-Wolf-in-Sheep's-Clothing....do come in."

(MA enters and sits with her head down.)

RW "How can I help you child?"

MA (Still sits with her head down, then bursts into tears.) "Oh Reverend....I'm so ashamed and disgusted with myself....I've been committing adultery."

RW "Oh...Poor child.."

MA "I can't sleep at night.....And I can't eat...And everyone tells me how evil it is....I'm at my wit's end."

RW "Do you ever read bumper stickers?"

MA "What?"

RW "Bumper stickers....You know, on cars?"

MA "Sometimes....Why?"

RW "Have you read the one that says 'God is Love'?"

MA "Well....Yes....But why?"

RW "If God is Love...Can Love ever be wrong?"

MA "But everyone tells me that what I'm doing is so wrong."

<u>RW</u> "Wrong?....If God is Love...And what you're doing is so wrong....Then God is wrong....Love is *never* wrong....Because God is Love."

<u>MA</u> "Hmm...I've never thought of it like that....But if it's right why do I have such bad feelings of condemnation?....And my friends tell me the Bible says..."

<u>RW</u> (Interrupting.) "People who quote the Bible will have a lot to answer for at The Judgement....If I believed there was a Judgement....Which I don't."

MA "But they told me the Bible says...."

RW (Interrupting.) "Those verses probably weren't even in the originals."

MA "Well....Could you pray about this for me?"

RW "Pray?...You don't need prayer child...You need counselling."

MA "Counselling?"

<u>RW</u> "Yes, counselling....To help You overcome those feelings of Condemnation and Guilt you're living under....And to lift your Self-esteem to a level where you can walk down the street with your head held high...Knowing that everything you do is good...Because God is good."

<u>MA</u> "Really?...And to think I've been dreading coming here, because I thought you'd tell me I'm going to Hell."

<u>RW</u> "Hell?...There's no such place as Hell...And if there was...People like you wouldn't go there....Only bad people would."

MA "Really?"

RW "Do you call yourself a Christian?"

MA "Yes!....Well...I used to..."

RW "Where do Christians go?"

MA "To Heaven?"

RW "Yes....To Heaven.....So you'll go to Heaven!"

MA "Oh...I feel so much better already."

<u>MA</u> "Yes....I can see that now...And thank you for helping me.....But what shall I do about the Church I go to?....They keep telling me it's so wrong and...."

<u>RW</u> (Interrupting) "Sounds like a terrible place to me....Don't stay around critics like them...Find a Church where you'll be accepted....! could even recommend one."

MA "Yes do please."

<u>RW</u> "As you know 'Birds of a feather flock together'....I'd go to the 'Church-of-the-Woman-taken-in-Adultery' if I were you.....They're understanding and non-judgemental....You'd fit in perfectly."

MA "Good...I'll do that...And thank you so much for your advice."

RW "That's what I'm here for...I'm a Wolff-in-Sheep's-Clothing after all."

MA "Well...Goodbye."

RW "Bye."
