We can sail on this earth for about 80 years, then there's an Eternity beyond that. Isn't it wise to find out what choices we have for our last port? Or, you will sail blindly into unchartered waters hoping to be safe? Please take the time to consider the best course, and make a wise decision.

We were created to live Eternally, but, when Adam and Eve sinned, they were separated from God. And we were all born separated from Him. Unless we can atone for the sin that separates us, we will die separated from Him, and go to the Judgement and the end of our existence.

Sin means 'to miss the mark,' and any act that falls short of Divine Perfection is sin, because God is Holy. Because we were already separated from God, no amount of 'good works' could restore us to Him.

We were totally without hope. Then God Himself stepped in to save us.

'God was in Christ reconciling the world unto Himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them...' (2 Corinthians 5:19).

'For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is Eternal Life through Jesus Christ our Lord.' (Roman's 6:23).
